Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how Islam in Bristol collects, uses, stores and protects personal information in accordance with the UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018. Information we may collect includes names, email addresses, telephone numbers and any information submitted through contact forms or enquiries. We use this information to respond to enquiries, administer services, improve the website and comply with legal obligations. Personal information is stored securely using password-protected systems and access is limited to authorised personnel. Where cloud storage is used, appropriate security measures such as Microsoft 365/OneDrive access controls and encryption are applied. We do not sell personal information to third parties. Information is only shared where required by law or with trusted service providers acting on our behalf. Data is retained only for as long as necessary and then securely deleted. Individuals have the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict processing, object to processing and lodge a complaint with the UK Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
